Gunnar Myrdal as a Weberian public intellectual: Max Webers methodological heritage

The paper briefly contextualizes Webers methodology, with its antinomical stands, and characterizes the core of Webers methodology as the rational actor model. It states Weber as an anti-sociologist within sociology and an exponent of secularization in social science. The notion of Gunnar Myrdal (1898-1987) as a more radical and applied Weberian, calling for a further investigation of Science, Values, and Politics in Gunnar Myrdals methodology, is elaborated.
